

HOW OUR AUSTRALIND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CANTEEN OPERATES:

1. OUR CANTEEN :

Is an essential part of our P&C activities and offers students a great service. It means that the monies raised by the canteen of about \$30,000 each year can be put back into the school for our children. It also means that as a P&C we do not have to raise funds independently. This means that we do not have to sell raffle tickets, have fetes etc. Think of your help in the canteen as a way of assisting our fund raising.

Our canteen is a partnership between parents, staff and students.

2. OUR STAFF:

Dee Barry is our Canteen Manager and is responsible for the day-to-day management and operations of all aspects of the canteen. Trish Riddick assists Dee and Teresa Fish works on a casual basis. All staff are employed by the ASHS P&C association who is responsible for the legal running of the canteen.

3. OUR VOLUNTEERS:

We rely on parents to help in our canteen as due to the numbers of students we cannot get through the queues during lunch and recess. We need at least one parent helper for 2 hours each day to ensure all children get their lunch! This is not much given the numbers of children at our school. Our volunteers have a list of duties we ask them to do under the directions of Dee. We really appreciate the people who commit to assisting in the canteen as the monies can be spent on a range of items for our kids.

4. DUTIES OF OUR VOLUNTEERS:

It is not hard to help at the canteen but it is always very busy. If you are thinking of helping you can expect to do some of the following things:

Prepare hot foods such as hot dogs and hot chicken rolls

Make up trays of ordered food, may include hot and cold foods

Washing dishes and utensils
